Proverbs 6

Colossians 3

Proverbs 13

This chapter highlights that the soul of the diligent is richly supplied, encouraging consistent effort and discouraging procrastination.

Ecclesiastes 9

This chapter urges us to do whatever our hand finds to do with all our might, reminding us to seize the moment and act without delay.

James 4

James reminds us that life is fleeting, encouraging us to act now and not to procrastinate in doing what is good.

Proverbs 12

This chapter contrasts the diligent with the lazy, showing the rewards of hard work and the pitfalls of procrastination.

Romans 12

Paul exhorts believers to not be slothful in zeal, but to be fervent in spirit, serving the Lord, encouraging proactive and passionate action.

Luke 12

Jesus teaches about being watchful and ready, emphasizing the importance of being prepared and not delaying in our responsibilities.

Proverbs 10

This chapter contrasts the wise who gather during harvest with those who sleep in harvest, showing the consequences of procrastination.

Galatians 6

Paul encourages believers not to grow weary in doing good, for in due season we will reap if we do not give up, urging persistence and action.

2 Thessalonians 3

Paul commands that everyone should work and not be idle, encouraging diligence and a strong work ethic.

Hebrews 6

This chapter urges us to show diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end, discouraging laziness and procrastination.

Proverbs 31

The Proverbs 31 woman is praised for her diligence, rising early and working with willing hands, serving as an example of avoiding procrastination.

Ephesians 5

Paul instructs believers to make the most of every opportunity because the days are evil, urging us to act without delay.

Matthew 25

Jesus' parable of the talents teaches the importance of using what God has given us without delay, warning against burying our gifts through procrastination.
