### Psalm 27

David expresses confidence in the Lord as his light and salvation, addressing fear with trust in God's protection.

## Isaiah 41

God reassures His people that they need not fear because He is with them, upholding them with His righteous right hand.

## 2 Timothy 1

Paul encourages Timothy by reminding him that God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind.

## Psalm 91

This chapter speaks of God's protection and refuge, providing comfort and assurance against fear.

# Joshua 1

God commands Joshua to be strong and courageous, assuring him of His presence as he leads the people, which can encourage anyone facing fear.

#### Isaiah 43

God reassures His people that they should not fear, for He has redeemed them and will be with them through every trial.

#### Romans 8

Paul teaches that nothing can separate us from the love of God, emphasizing that God's love casts out fear and gives us security.

## Psalm 23

David speaks of the Lord as his shepherd, who leads him beside still waters and comforts him, even in the valley of the shadow of death.

# 1 John 4

John speaks about God's perfect love, which drives out fear, providing confidence and security in God's love.

### Exodus 14

The Israelites face the Red Sea, and Moses encourages them not to be afraid, but to stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will bring.

# Deuteronomy 31

Moses assures the Israelites that God will be with them as they enter the Promised Land, encouraging them to be strong and courageous.

#### Psalm 46

This chapter portrays God as a refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble, which can alleviate fear.

#### Matthew 6

Jesus teaches not to worry about tomorrow, focusing instead on seeking God's kingdom, which helps combat the fear of the future.

#### Hebrews 13

The author encourages believers to be content and free from the love of money because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

#### Proverbs 3

This chapter encourages trust in the Lord with all your heart and not leaning on your understanding, which counters fear with faith.
