A plan of devotion, purpose, and prayers





Psalm 51

David's prayer of repentance after his sin with Bathsheba, asking God for a clean heart and renewal of spirit, is powerful for those battling lust.

Matthew 5

Jesus teaches about the seriousness of lust and urges believers to take drastic measures to avoid it, emphasizing purity of heart.

1 Thessalonians 4

Paul instructs believers to live a holy life, controlling their bodies in a way that is honorable and not driven by lustful passion.

Job 31

Job makes a covenant with his eyes not to look lustfully at a young woman, demonstrating the importance of guarding our eyes and heart.

1 Corinthians 6

Paul reminds us that our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit and that we should flee from sexual immorality, living in purity.

Ephesians 5

This chapter warns against sexual immorality and impurity, calling believers to walk in the light and live as children of light.

Proverbs 7

This chapter provides a vivid warning against the seduction of lust, urging wisdom and understanding to avoid its traps.

Colossians 3

Paul encourages believers to put to death whatever belongs to their earthly nature, including lust, and to put on the new self, renewed in the image of God.

Galatians 5

Paul contrasts the works of the flesh, including sexual immorality, with the fruit of the Spirit, urging believers to live by the Spirit.

Romans 13

Paul instructs believers to clothe themselves with the Lord Jesus Christ and not to think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh, emphasizing a focus on Christ.

James 1

James speaks about how temptation leads to sin and death, urging believers to resist temptation and persevere under trial.

Proverbs 5

This chapter warns against adultery and calls for faithfulness in marriage, emphasizing the importance of staying away from the path of lust.

2 Timothy 2

Paul advises fleeing youthful passions and pursuing righteousness, faith, love, and peace, alongside those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.

Psalm 119

This chapter emphasizes the importance of hiding God's word in our hearts to avoid sin, providing strength against the temptation of lust.

1 John 2

John warns against the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, urging believers to do the will of God instead of pursuing worldly desires.
